



WARNING

The engine has exposed rotating parts. Switch OFF the engine before working in the engine compartment. Do not use the machine with the engine cover open. $\overline{5\cdot2\cdot6\cdot5}$

! CAUTION

Hot oil and engine components can burn you. Make sure the engine is cool before doing this job.

- 1 Make the machine safe with the boom lowered. Stop the engine. Refer to **Section 3 Routine Maintenance**.
- 2 Open the engine cover. Refer to **Section 3 Routine** *Maintenance*.

- **3** Support the engine cover **A**.

Remove bolts **B** and nuts **C** from the hinges **D** at both sides of the engine cover **A**.

5 Remove the engine cover from the machine.

Replacement

Replacement is the opposite of the removal procedure.
